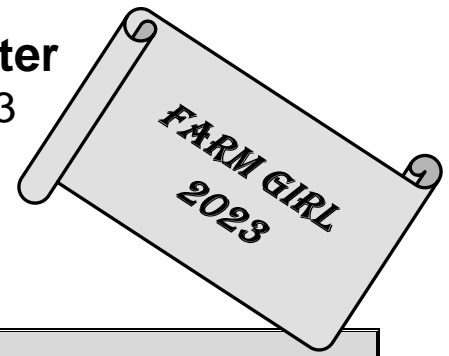

1. Machine Quilted-Freehand:		No computerized or digital quilting used
2. Machine Quilted-Computer Aided:		any portion quilted by computer, even if balance was freehand quilted
3. Machine Quilted-Combo:		Combination of computerized & freehand quilting
4. Applique:		Choose 1 - Hand or Machine (Minimum size 144") Main focus: applique in combinations with piecing
5. Embroidery:		Choose 1 - Hand or Machine (Minimum size 144") Main focus: embroidery in combinations with piecing
6. Hand Quilted:		Must be entirely hand quilted: whole cloth, applique, piecing, hand embroidery or combination of techniques
7. Modern Quilt Design:		Contemporary, bold, colorful, inspired by modern design, asymmetrical expansive negative space, typically no border, dense graphic quilting, majority of fabric reads solid
8. Mixed Media:		Fabric Art Quilt, Original Design, Wall Display* must be entirely original design (Size: up to 250")
9. Quilted Wall Hanging:		Public domain or commercial pattern used (Size: up to 250")
10. Small Quilted Home Décor*, Wearable Art		
11. Youth		– pieced by someone up to 18 years old
12. Juvenile Themed Quilt:		specifically intended for young, juvenile person; baby quilt, crib quilt, etc.
13. General, novelty, or combination of techniques:		yo-yo, t-shirt, tied, embellished, painted, cathedral window, crazy quilts
14. Group Quilt, and/or Round Robin:		1 quilt made by 3 or more people
15. Wool Quilted Project:		Item must have 3 layers-top, batting & backing, quilted by machine or hand & be at least 50% wool on top
16. WSQ Challenge:		(Limited to WSQ members only) per instruction packet purchased at quarterly meetings
17. WSQ 2022-2023 Mystery Quilt		(Limited to WSQ members only)
18. Machine Quilting Challenge:		(Limited to INMQ members only) per instruction.
19. Treasure Quilt:		(Limited to INMQ Members only) Antique Quilts or Quilt Blocks made into a quilt per instructions.(Minimum 160")

Instructions

Filling Out the Quilt Entry Form:

1. Each form is for one entry. If you are doing several entries, consider doing them online – you will only need to put in your name & address once!
2. Include your phone number and email address in case there is a problem with your entry. WSQ will only use them if there is a problem and **will not** share it.
3. Please print CLEARLY and double check!
4. Choose a Drop-Off location from the list on the left and write it on the entry form.
5. Make sure you check the CORRECT category on your entry form. See the website for category information.
6. Fill in the Made By, Quilted By, Designer, Width and Length in inches. Include the Title and a Description.
7. Solo-Duo and Large-Small categories will be determined by Made By / Quilted By and Size.
8. Mail this form to: Kristin Echols,

 be sure to keep copy for your records.
9. Must be postmarked by **Sunday, August 6**

Prepping the quilt for the show:

10. Write the word "top" on a piece of muslin and slip stitch it to the TOP CENTER BACK of your quilt.
11. Label each quilt with your name, address and phone number on muslin stitched to the LOWER LEFT BACK of your quilt (on the left when viewed from the back).
12. Place each quilt in a CLEAR or WHITE PLASTIC BAG that can be securely closed and does not need to be returned.

Dropping off the quilt, and picking it up:

13. If you need to change your drop-off location, contact the Registration Team.
14. Your quilt bag label and receipt will be ready for you ONLY at the location you put on the form. DO NOT drop elsewhere without working with the Registration Team.
15. Drop offs are from Sat, Oct 7 through Sat, Oct 14 at the location you put on the entry form.
16. When you Drop-Off your quilt, your bag is labeled, and you get a receipt for it. You will need that receipt to pick up your quilt after the show.
17. Pick up your quilt on Sunday, Oct.22 between 6:00-7:00 pm at the Fairgrounds (404 N. Havana, Spokane)
