Robin Ruth Design "Around Robin" Supply List Skill Level - Advanced Beginner

Students should have experience piecing and be prepared to move along at a fairly quick pace in class. Good rotary cutting skills and accurate sewing are a plus for this class.

Class Description

Create this 17½" mandala style block using techniques that are common in Robin Ruth Design patterns. We will make a faced circle center, a 45° Dresden band, and some faced petals to create this finished block that can be applied to any larger project you choose! Robin will give other examples in class of how these techniques are used in many of her patterns to go along with her strip pieced mariner's compass blocks.

All work to make these blocks will be done in class.
