

Instructions

Filling Out the Quilt Entry Form:

- 1. Each form is for one entry. If you are doing several entries, consider doing them online you will only need to put in your name & address once!
- 2. Include your phone number and email address in case there is a problem with your entry. WSQ will only use them if there is a problem and *will not* share it.
- 3. Please print CLEARLY and double check!
- 4. Choose a Drop-Off location from the list on the left and write it on the entry form.
- 5. Make sure you check the CORRECT category on your entry form. See the website for category information.
- 6. Fill in the Made By, Quilted By, Designer, Width and Length in inches. Include the Title and a Description.
- 7. Solo-Duo and Large-Small categories will be determined by Made By / Quilted By and Size.
- Mail this form to: Kristin Echols, 14995 W Frost Rd, Worley, ID 83876; be sure to keep copy for your records.
- 9. Must be postmarked by Sunday, August 4

Prepping the quilt for the show:

- 10. Write the word "top" on a piece of muslin and slip stitch it to the TOP CENTER BACK of your quilt.
- 11. Label each quilt with your name, address and phone number on muslin stitched to the LOWER LEFT BACK of your quilt (on the left when viewed from the back).
- 12. Place each quilt in a CLEAR or WHITE PLASTIC BAG that can be securely closed and does not need to be returned.

Dropping off the quilt, and picking it up:

- 13. If you need to change your drop-off location, contact the Registration Team.
- 14. Your quilt bag label and receipt will be ready for you ONLY at the location you put on the form. DO NOT drop elsewhere without working with the Registration Team.
- 15. Drop offs are from Sat, Oct 5 through Sat, Oct 12 at the location you put on the entry form.
- 16. When you Drop-Off your quilt, your bag is labeled, and you get a receipt for it. You will need that receipt to pick up your quilt after the show.
- 17. Pick up your quilt on Sunday, Oct.20 between 6:00-7:00 pm at the Fairgrounds (404 N. Havana, Spokane)
