1. Machine Quilted-Freehand: (No computerized or digital quilting used)		
2. Machine Quilted-Computer Aided: any portion quilted by computer, even if balance was freehand quilted		
3. Machine Applique: Main focus: machine applique in combination with piecing (Minimum size 144")		
4. Hand Applique: Main focus: hand applique in combination with piecing (Minimum size 144")		
5. Hand Quilted: Must be entirely hand quilted, whole cloth, applique, piecing, hand embroidery or combination of techniques – machine piecing OK		
6. Modern Quilt Design: Contemporary, bold, colorful, inspired by modern design, asymmetrical expansive negative space, typically no border, dense graphic quilting, majority of fabric reads solid		
7. Mixed Media: Fabric Art Quilt, Original Design, Wall Display* <i>must be entirely original design (Size: up to 250")</i>		
8. Quilted Wall Hanging Public domain or commercial pattern used (Size: up to 250")		
9. Small Quilted Home Décor, Wearable Art		
10. Youth: quilt pieced by a youth up to 18 years old		
11. Miniature Quilts: miniaturized piecing, maximum block size 4" blocks, 1/4" binding, (size: up to 48") – not small wall hangings		
12. General, novelty, or combination of techniques: yo-yo, t-shirt, tied, embellished, painted, cathedral window, crazy quilts, machine or hand embroidered, etc.		
13. Group Quilt, and/or Round Robin: 1 quilt made by 3 or more people		
14. Wool Quilted Project: Item must have 3 layers (top, batting & backing), quilted by machine or hand & be at least 50% wool on top		
15. WSQ Challenge: (WSQ members only) per instruction packet purchased at quarterly meetings		
16. WSQ Mystery Quilt (WSQ members only) Finding Grace or Wandering Grace		
17. Machine Quilting Challenge: (Limited to INMQ members only) per instructions		
18. Treasure Quilt: (Limited to INMQ members only) Applique block made into a quilt. (Minimum 144")		
Some categories have sub-categories of Solo (made & quilted by same person) or Duo (made & quilted by another person) and/or Large or Small

The Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to refuse to display any entry not meeting WSQ standards. All entries must be made of cloth and may not be framed, on stretcher bars or under glass. All entries must be capable of being pinned to a sheet or sleeve.	

Professional Quilt Judging
You can choose to have any entered quilt professionally judged for a fee of \$10 paid at registration . This judging is separate from the show's Category Ribbons.

Instructions

Filling Out the Quilt Entry Form:

1. Each form is for one entry. If you are doing several entries, consider doing them online – you will only need to put in your name & address once!
2. Include your phone number and email address in case there is a problem with your entry. WSQ will only use them if there is a problem and **will not** share it.
3. Please print CLEARLY and double check!
4. Choose a Drop-Off location from the list on the left and write it on the entry form.
5. Make sure you check the CORRECT category on your entry form. See the website for category information.
6. Fill in the Made By, Quilted By, Designer, Width and Length in inches. Include the Title and a Description.
7. Solo-Duo and Large-Small categories will be determined by Made By / Quilted By and Size.
8. Mail this form to: Colleen Mussetter,

be sure to keep copy for your records.
9. Must be postmarked by **Sunday, July 27**

Prepping the quilt for the show:

10. Write the word "top" on a piece of muslin and slip stitch it to the TOP CENTER BACK of your quilt.
11. Label each quilt with your name, address and phone number on muslin stitched to the LOWER LEFT BACK of your quilt (on the left when viewed from the back).
12. Place each quilt in a CLEAR or WHITE PLASTIC BAG that can be securely closed and does not need to be returned.

Dropping off the quilt, and picking it up:

13. If you need to change your drop-off location, contact the Registration Team.
14. Your quilt bag label and receipt will be ready for you ONLY at the location you put on the form. DO NOT drop elsewhere without working with the Registration Team.
15. Drop offs are from Sat, Oct 4 through Sat, Oct 11 at the location you put on the entry form.
16. When you Drop-Off your quilt, your bag is labeled, and you get a receipt for it. You will need that receipt to pick up your quilt after the show.
17. Pick up your quilt on Sunday, Oct 19 between 6:00-7:00 pm at the Fairgrounds (404 N. Havana, Spokane)
