

This quilt is based on a pattern by Kimberlee Peers-Moore for Northcott Fabrics.

This kit contains: 6 Piece A @ 5.5" x 11.5", 6 Piece B @ 5.5" x 11.5"

12 each of Piece C, D, E @ 3.5" x 6.5"

6 strips @ 1.5" x WOF for sashing in blocks (F). From these cut 24 @ 6.5", and 12 @ 11.5"

6 strips @ 1.5" x WOF for sashing between blocks (G). From this cut 8 @ 1.5" x 11.5". Piece the rest together and cut 5 @ 35.5" to put between horizontal rows of blocks and 2 @ 50" for vertical side sashing.

6 strips (H) @ 4.5" X WOF for borders

Sew a 1.5" x 6.5" sashing strip (F) onto each side of the 12 pieces of fabric D. This will be the center. Stitch C and E to either side of D to make a three-rectangle piece. Make 12.

Sew a 11.5" sashing rectangle (F) to one long side of each of the Piece A or B. Attach this piece to the three-rectangle piece to make a block. Make 12.

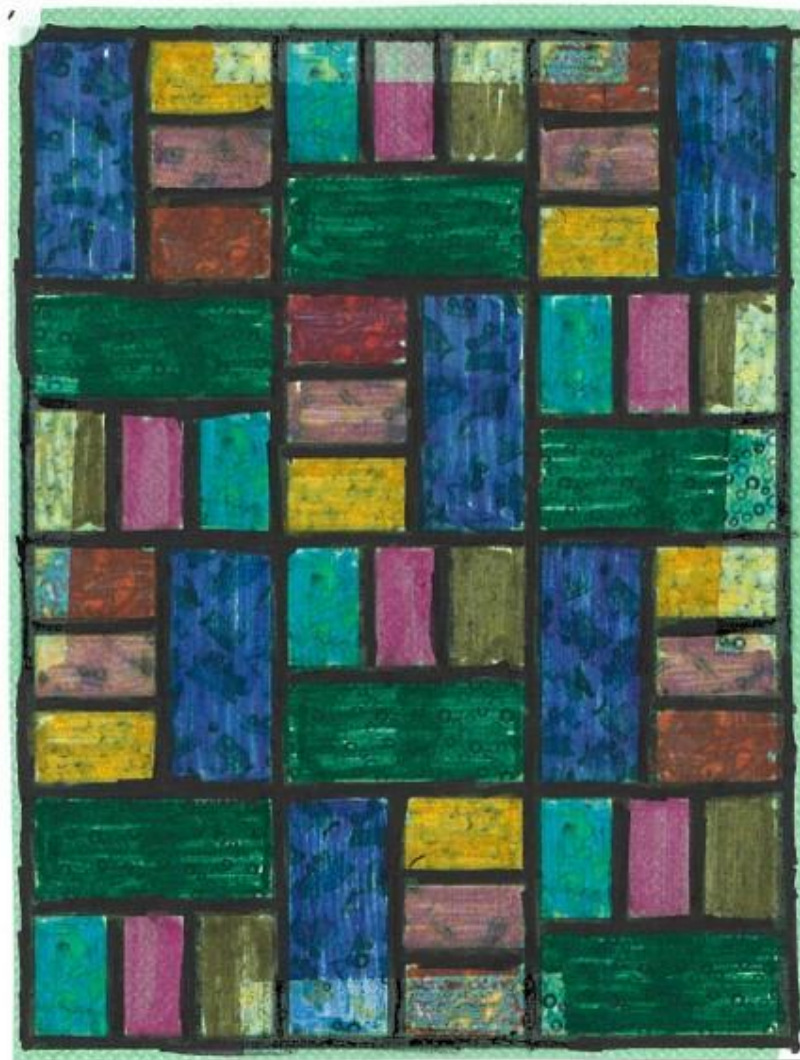
Lay out the 12 blocks 3 x 4, alternating direction and Piece A and B fabric. Put sashing (G) between blocks (1.5" x 11.5"). Make 4 rows of three blocks and sashing.

Put (G) strips (1.5" x 35.5") at the bottom of each of the rows and another one on the top of Row One. Put rows together and add side sashing (1.5" x 50"). Trim as needed.

Measure and add (H) borders.
