

Chevron Heart

This kit includes:

72 @ 6.5" dark triangles,

76 @ 6.5" light triangles,

24 @ 3.5" dark squares.

Construct the heart first by piecing together 10 half square triangle blocks using the "heart" color. Piece together 6 @ Four Patch blocks from 3.5" squares. Piece 2 half square triangle blocks using two background triangles each, so that they make 2 @ 6 ½" blocks the color of the background. The heart block is a 4 x 4 grid that makes one large block. Arrange according to the picture and stitch together.

Each chevron row consists of two rows of half square triangle blocks. Stitch the light and dark triangles together. Press half to the light and half to the dark. Lay out in rows according to color and so that diagonal seam lines nest. Stitch those two rows of blocks together to make one double row. Repeat for the other two chevron rows. Lay out the heart and its color coordinated chevrons, along with the "background" triangle blocks. Be sure the background blocks have their seam lines oriented correctly. Sew the side sections together and attach to the heart.

Assemble all the double rows according to the picture.

Stitch around the outside edge of the quilt to prevent seams from popping open.
