Are you ready to conquer curve piecing and make a fun table runner in the process? In the Conquering Basic Curves with Confidence workshop, we'll go over the basics of curve piecing from making templates to basting techniques and sewing curves. After completing your first tulip you'll know how to piece both quarter circles and orange peel blocks, techniques you'll be able to use for any curve including a double wedding ring design.

* Tulip table runner quilt kit, includes all fabric need to complete the quilt top and template plastic - **\$20**

- *Thread
- *Scissors

*Cutting mat, rotary cutter and minimum 6-1/2" wide ruler

- *Glue stick
- *Pins
- * Any other notions/tools needed to piece a quilt block
- * Iron and Ironing board
- * Paper and Pen/Pencil
- * Fabric pen/marker



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
