Class Description

Pineapple log cabin blocks are so beautiful. They are dynamic enough to stand on their own, to build an entire quilt from or to be the connecting link between different blocks. This amazing block is also a great way to learn how to paper piece. Paper piecing may seem complicated, but it is a great skill to have in your quilting repertoire. It can be fun and very relaxing. In this workshop we'll go through the steps to successfully paper piece a pineapple log cabin with some great tips to help you on the way.

Come join us and learn how to paper piece and pineapple log cabin and make a beautiful 20" x 20" wall hanging, center piece or pillow top.

Required Materials

- * Pineapple wall hanging quilt kit, includes all fabric need to complete 4 pineapple log cabins and paper templates \$25
- *Thread
- *Scissors
- *Cutting mat, rotary cutter and minimum 2-1/2" wide ruler
- *Glue stick
- *Pins
- *Serrated Tracing Wheel and seam or wheel presser
- * Any other notions/tools needed to piece a quilt block
- * Iron and Ironing board
- * Paper and Pen/Pencil
