- Laptop PC or MAC computer with EQ8 installed, activated and updated PRIOR TO CLASS.
- Power cord and a mouse (required).
- Extension cord.
- Paper and pen.
- Download and print out the User Quick Start Guide. (48 pages so put lots of paper in your printer and print on both sides of the paper). You will find this on the www.electricquilt.com website. There is a link to it on the Home Page of the software.

You DO NOT need to print out the larger User Manual. I recommend that if you want to have a print copy of the User Manual, save the file to a USB drive and take it to a print shop where they can print it out in color and add a spiral binding.

Additional Information to make your class easier and more fun.

- 1. Bring a buddy so you can help each other.
- 2. Auditing the class is not permitted. This is a hands-on only experience.
- 3. Play around with the program beforehand and write down questions you want to ask.
- 4. Write down a list of the 3 most important skills you want to accomplish with EQ8.
- 5. You cannot effectively draw and design with a touchpad. You must have a mouse.
- 6. You can run EQ8 on an Android tablet but NOT on an iPad. Use a laptop only in the class.
- 7. Create a Cloud account to save your project files so you can work on more than one computer. You can only activate the program on 2 computers at a time.
- 8. It is possible to take the Day 2 class without taking the Day 1 class **IF you have at least minimal experience with EQ8**.
