Cheryl Clossin - Fearless Applique and Embellishment

April 24, 2026 9 am - 4 pm

This is a beginner friendly to intermediate appliqué & embellishment class. You will learn the basics of traditional needle turn appliqué, including preparation, needle turn basics and how to use notions and tools to make leaves, stems and circles easy and fun to add to your project. You will learn traditional freezer paper appliqué for needle turn. This is a great class to hone your skills or learn a new technique using some great tools.



In the second half of the class, we will add embroidery and some beading to your appliqué block. You will learn basic and easy embroidery stitches to add interest and texture to your appliqué as well as a few more complicated stitches that are easy to master.

Supply List:

Pattern will be available for purchase at the meeting or class

Kit with fabrics will be available for purchase at the meeting or class, however you can choose to use your own fabrics from your stash.

FABRICS

- Background - fat quarter
- Greens – variety for stems and leaves
- Vase fabric 8 x 8"
- Variety of colors for flowers, flower centers & circles
- A fat quarter pack with good contrasting colors would work great or scraps with a variety of coordinating colors for flowers

SUPPLIES

- Freezer Paper
- Paper cutting scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Applique Pin
- Elmer School Glue or Roxanne's glue
- Thread – 50-80 wt threads in colors that match your applique fabrics
- Applique needles – bring a variety pack
- Beading needles – (I will have one in your kit)
- Seed beads or a variety of smaller beads
- Beading mat (Optional)
- Needle threader (Optional)
- Embroidery threads to match your fabric choices but bring a variety of colors
- Small hoop for embroidery
- Optional: Iron & Mat (irons are provided in the classroom)

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
