From Photo to Quilt

Class Description- Learn how to turn a favorite photo into a raw edge applique work of art. You will leave class with a full-size freezer paper pattern of your photo. We will also cover tips for fabric selection and using mixed media to add detail.

Skill level- Beginner

Supplies:

- Color Photo
- Black and white enlargement of the photo the size you want the quilt to be
- Freezer paper
- Slice Craft knife (Amazon)
- Steam a Seam Lite 2
- Sharp Scissors that can be used on the steam a seam
- Black fine point marker
- Muslin 3" larger around than your desired finished size quilt
- Assorted fabrics for your quilt top. Use your color photo for inspiration. Batiks and tone on tones work well.

Before You come to class-

- 1. Print your picture out in color. Size does not matter; you will be using this for color reference only.
- 2. Enlarge the picture to the size you want your quilt to be and print it out in **black and white**. Note-most copier stores will do this. Just bring it to them digitally and tell them the size you need. I recommend making it 24" x 36" or smaller for your first project.
