

Painting 101 Supply List

In class, we'll walk through how to transfer your design onto the fabric so it ends up perfectly centered.

A kit will be available for \$15.00, which includes paint brushes and a 11" x 15" foam core board.

- **Fabric paints:**

Recommended brands include Jacquard Textile paints and PROfab Transparent paints, which can be purchased online or at craft stores. Amazon, Dharma Trading Company, and Blick Art Materials are three online sources. Michaels and Craft Warehouse also sell Jacquard.

You will need primary/secondary colors – red, blue, yellow, orange, green, violet, and black and white.

Jacquard carries a packaged 8 Color **Primary/Secondary** Color Set: White, Black, True Red, Yellow, Orange, Emerald Green, Violet, Sapphire Blue.

- White Fabric to Paint: PFD (prepared for dyeing) or any tight weave white cotton fabric will suffice. You will need a rectangle about 14" x 12". Please do **NOT prewash the fabric.**

- Painter or Masking Tape

- Acrylic Paint Brushes: bristles should be **short** and stiff (can be purchased in packaged combinations and do not have to be expensive)

- Small round tip

- Medium round tip

- Small flat head

- ½" flat head for painting large areas

- Foam Core Board: 10" x 13" to tape fabric onto, available online, office supply, or craft stores.

- Sheet of Clear Plastic: 8 ½" x 11"
- Pencil: A mechanical pencil is recommended for fine lines.
- Light Box: If available.
 - Paint Tray/palette: A container for holding paints with room or compartments to mix paints. You can use a white plate. Alternatively, plastic wrap will be provided for transport.
 - Spritzer Bottle: Optional
 - Palette Knife: Optional but useful.
 - Ruler: at least a 12"
 - Black Sharpies: Fine and ultra-fine tips.
 - Water Holder: Can be a cup or plastic tub; a lower container is preferred for ease of brush access.
 - Rags or Paper Towels: A few of each to determine preference.
 - Scissors: Both paper scissors and fabric scissors.
 - Color wheel: Optional.
 - Small Brown Paper Bag: for trash
 - Plastic Tablecloth to Protect Tables
 - Camera: optional
 - Chair Pad: Optional
 - Protective Clothing: A paint shirt or apron to protect clothes, as acrylic paint stains.
