Using one of the Creative Grids Log Cabin Trim Tool, you have the option of choosing from four different sizes: 4", 6", 8", or 10", depending on the size and scale of block you'd like to make. You'll quickly learn the technique and complete multiple blocks during class.

**** Required for class: Choose one of the following:**

Creative Grids Log Cabin Trim Tool: 4" (CGRJAWMN4), or 6" (CGRJAWMN6), or 8" (CGRJAW1), or 10" (CGRJAW10) depending on what size blocks you'd like to make.

Irons and ironing boards will be provided by venue

In addition to the trim tool, attendees will need the following supplies:

- Sewing machine, thread, rotary cutter, scissors, basic sewing supplies
- Spinning mat (*highly recommended*)
- Choice of fabric to complete project
- Pressing mat and small personal iron
