### Treasure Box Block and its Variations:

In this class students will learn to create blocks for the Treasure Box Block Quilt. This is a fast and fun cutting technique and the layout possibilities are endless. Once applied to scraps in your arsenal, you can use up scraps in a fast and meaningful way. Color theory will also be discussed.

There are many ways to set this block in combination with other blocks that are simple half square triangles to yield many other designs.

This class is process oriented and students will not go home with a completed quilt but will have a solid knowledge of this block and how it can help them to rip through their scraps.

Purchase of book and template is highly recommended. Templates are required.

### Supply list for Treasure Box Block and its Variations

1. Rotary Cutter
2. Rotary mat
3. Templates 3 ½", 4 ½" and 5 ½" If you already have these at home, you may bring them. You don't need to purchase my 3 in 1 template if you already have these sizes but it's a lot easier with my template.

Note: a 5 inch ruler is NOT the same and cannot be substituted for the 5 ½" ruler.

4. Scraps of various colors and prints (Lots!) Mediums and Lights that can accommodate the 5 ½" square or Fat Quarters (10 to 12) of various colors and prints Mediums and Lights.

**Note: Do not bring charm squares or charm packs. They will not work.**

5. Dark Scraps (lots!) that coordinate with the scraps from #4. These scraps must be able to accommodate a 5 ½" square. Or, 10-12 fat quarters that are dark and coordinate with the scraps or fabrics in #4.
6. Sticky dots for the back of templates to prevent slippage or sandpaper dots.
7. 1 yard of solid white or off white or both.
8. Basic sewing supplies such as a seam ripper, pins, scissors, etc.
